Assessment. Assessment is currently ill conceived to support a broader curriculum. It is too time consuming, inaccurate (too often judging what pupils already know rather than progress in what they have learnt) and an adjunct rather than central to the learning process.

Factor 1: Curriculum implementation must be done the way it was designed to be done (i.e., with fidelity); in a consistent manner; and with challenges to students to facilitate the development and use of higher level

## **Components of Curriculum Implementation**

We summarized the 4 factors (socio-culture, educational resources, educational system, the quality of the teacher) which challenge the multi-level governance and decentralization of curriculum implementing as following: 1. Conflicts between borrowing western educational ideas and Chinese traditional culture and political system

## **Curriculum Implementation - OECD**

Curriculum change requires in-school management teams, principals and boards of management to lead the implementation of change in the school as an organisation. Effective curriculum change and implementation requires time, personal interaction, in-service training, and other forms of people-based support (Fullan, 1993).
