In order to become a medical examiner, one has to be a licensed doctor (MD or DO) and take a licensing exam regardless of the state where he or she works. Medical licensing is done on a state by state basis and requirements vary. All require medical school, passing all four tests of the USMLE, and extensive training (residency).

The United States Department of Transportation (FMCSA), Medical Examiner certification was developed to certify medical examiners who can determine whether a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) driver meets Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) standards and guidelines. Candidates must be an advanced practice nurse, doctor of chiropractic, doctor of medicine, doctor of osteopathy, physician assistant, or other medical professional authorized by applicable State laws and regulations ...

Army COOL Snapshot - Medical Examiner Certification

In order to drive a commercial vehicle in the U.S. with a maximum gross vehicle weight rating of over 10,000 lbs in interstate commerce , drivers are required to pass a physical examination given by a DOT-approved medical examiner to obtain and maintain a medical examiner's certificate.. Drivers receive a medical certification which is normally valid for 2 years.

The examiner must be listed on the National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners to do the commercial driver license, commercial learner permit or commercial motor vehicle medical examinations.
